As referenced in F. S. 1008.25 (7)(b)(2)(g), Summer Reading Camps are available to each third grader scoring Level 1 on FCAT. The purpose of these intensive camps is to make sure students are stronger readers whether they will repeat third grade or move on to fourth grade. Each district designs a camp using state guidelines grounded in research.

Since 2003, the Florida Legislature has funded Just Read, Florida! As part of *No Child Left Behind*, *Reading First* is a competitive grant program that provides participating districts with principal and teacher training, highly-trained reading coaches, and research-based materials and assessments for grades K-3. Currently, 584 schools across the state are participating. Regional coordinators with strong reading and teaching backgrounds work with each *Reading First* school to provide instructional support.
