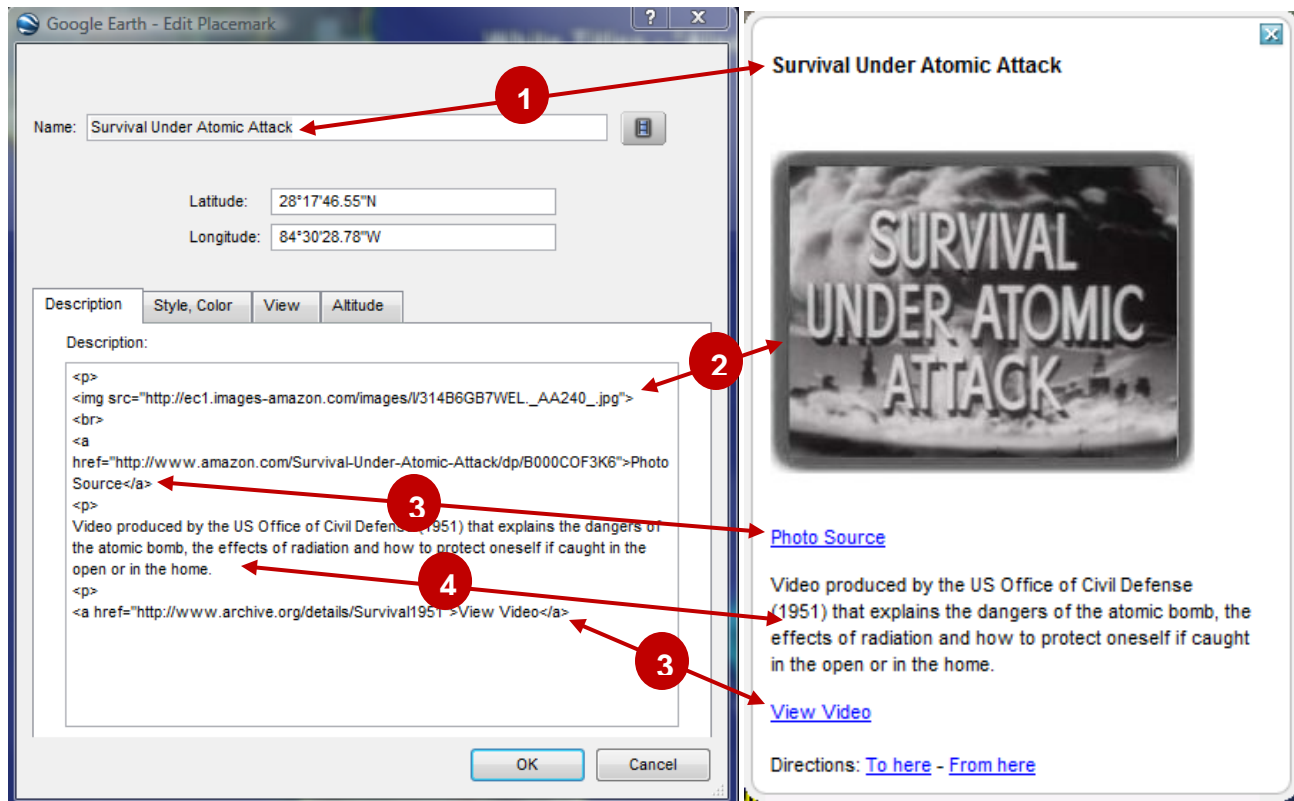

1. Whatever is typed in Name box appears as top line of popup in Bold.

2. To insert an image.
Code used: ``

3. To hyperlink to other online sources.
Code used: `linked text`

4. Can simply type text

5. Can use html code

To bold a word or phrase use `` before the word/phrase and `` immediately after
Ex: `This would give this` → **This would give this**

To italicize a word or phrase use `<i>` before the word/phrase and `</i>` immediately after
Ex: `<i>This would give this</i>` → *This would give this*

Can be used together:

Ex: `<i>This would give this</i>` → ***This would give this***

Also:

`<p>` inserts a blank line between sentences

`
` inserts a line break, but no blank line between sentences.
