Schedule - CAR-PD Professional Development

**September–December,
2006**

The 60 hour CAR-PD Academy curriculum will be drafted and will incorporate district/school feedback (40 hours seat time and 20 hours action research in their content area). CAR-PD candidates should complete FOR-PD in the fall semester of 2006, as it is a prerequisite to the 60 hour CAR-PD Academy to be offered second semester or during the summer. (The spring semester is also an option for FOR-PD for those participating in the Academy in the summer.)

December, 2006

The FLARE Coordinators will be trained in the CAR-PD Academy curriculum.

**January-May,
2007**

The training the trainers in each FLARE Coordinator's area will be conducted. Reading coaches would be the primary trainees, though content area teachers and district staff could also attend. The training will be conducted for the 60 hour CAR-PD Academy and also for the clinical mentorship for the practicum supervision.

The FLARE Coordinator will arrange for meeting space at a central location and decide on the training times and dates with the input of principals.

The FLaRE Coordinator will contact each middle and high school principal in their area to share the training details.

Upon completion of the 40 hour portion of the Academy, the new CAR-PD trainer will submit the required 20 hours of action research in their content area to the FLaRE Coordinator. Upon sign-off from the FLaRE Coordinator, the CAR-PD trainer's name will be added to a master spread sheet of CAR-PD trainers that will be shared with principals, reading endorsement contacts, and K-12 Reading Plan Contacts.

January – May, 2007

Upon completing their own CAR-PD Academy, reading coaches/content area teachers/district staff will train content area teachers who are CAR-PD candidates at their respective schools and supervise their 30 hour practicum (FLaRE model). The schedules for completion would vary from district to district.

Summer, 2007

The Just Read, Florida! office and FLaRE will offer a CAR-PD Summer Academy. Approximately 1,000 CAR-PD candidates statewide will be invited to attend, on a first come, first served basis, a CAR-PD Summer Academy for five days at a hotel in the central portion of the state. Lodging will be provided. District will be asked to sponsor transportation and per diem.

Fall 2007

The teachers who were trained at the CAR-PD Summer Academy would complete their CAR-PD 30 hour practicum under the supervision of a clinical mentor, who would preferably be someone from the trainee's home school. (Other CAR-PD candidates, who completed the CAR-PD Academy in the spring at their home school could also complete the practicum if they haven't already.) Teachers who had completed FOR-PD and the 60 hour CAR-PD Academy, could provide reading intervention to Level 2 students while simultaneously completing their practicum. Therefore, students would begin to be served by CAR-PD trained teachers during the 2007-2008 school year.
